

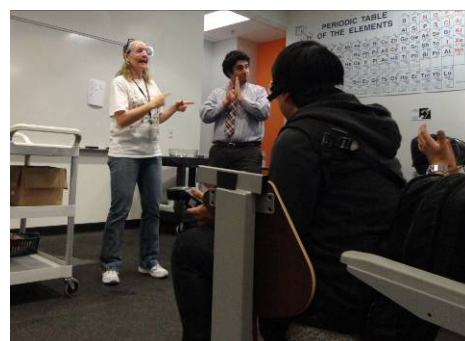
LACC CHEMISTRY CLUB NEWSLETTER

LACC Chemistry Club creates a spectacular event in honor of National Chemistry Week.

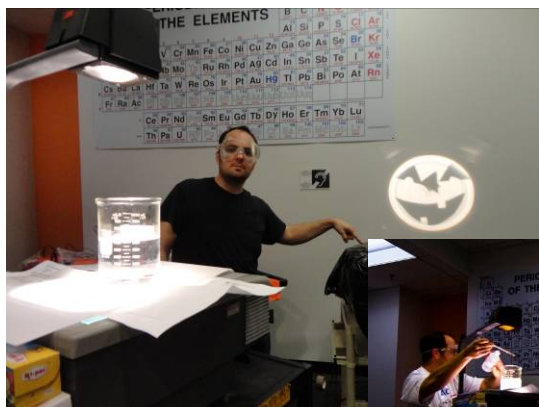

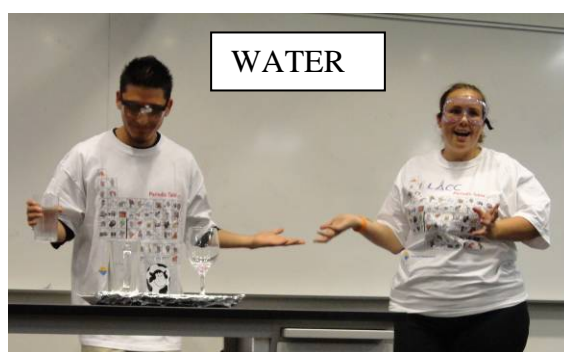


The show starts with some Physical chemistry; splitting a flame to the left and non-Newtonian fluids (Can you say “Big Bang theory”?) to the right.



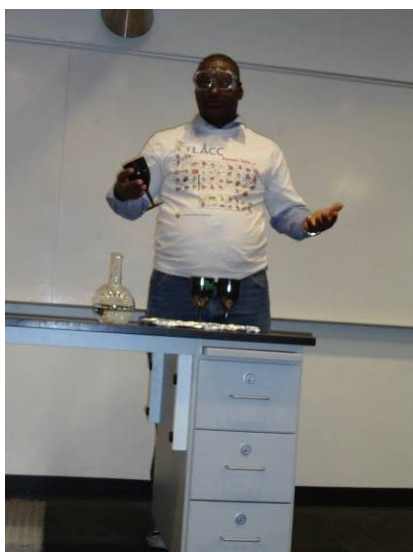

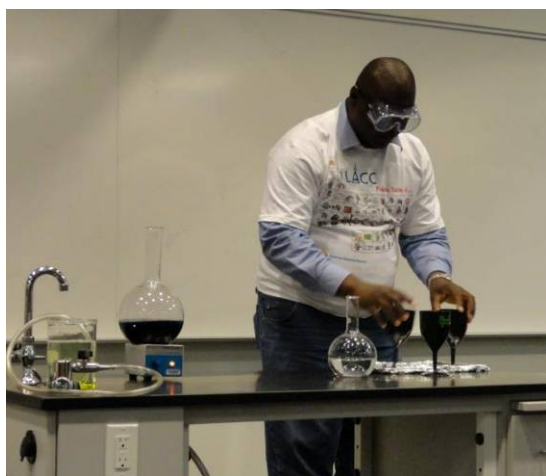




The little ones were fascinated by the wonders and versatility of dry ice. Bubbles, balloons, and COLD!



“MAGIC” is all in the presentation and these two guys knew how to present! The unlimited water glass and elephant’s toothpaste are always crowd pleasers.

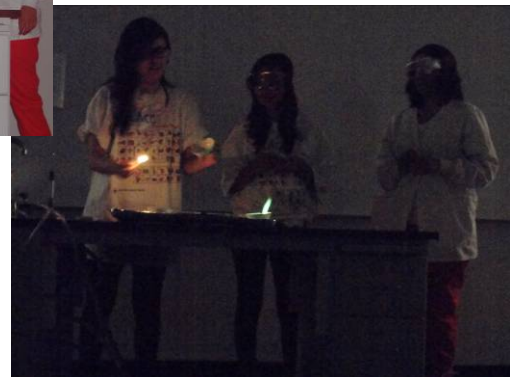


FIRE, FIRE EVERYWHERE!
